



Supervisor Talking Points

As a group discuss the following:

- Different types of confined spaces that may be entered (tanks, bins, hoppers, etc).
- Different types of entry points on confined spaces (side, top, etc.).
- Types of hazards that may be faced (engulfment, electrical, moving equipment, temperature extremes, etc.).
- Types of equipment required for entry (lifelines, harnesses, retrieval, PPE, etc.).
- Types of equipment that may need to be isolated prior to entry (fill spouts, conveyors, reclaim systems, sweep augers, etc.)
- Proper operation of atmospheric testing equipment.
- Communication means between entrant and attendants (radio, visual, voice, etc.).
- Confined space entry permit and how to properly complete it.
- Procedures for contacting rescue services.
- Any issues or concerns from employees based on past entries.
